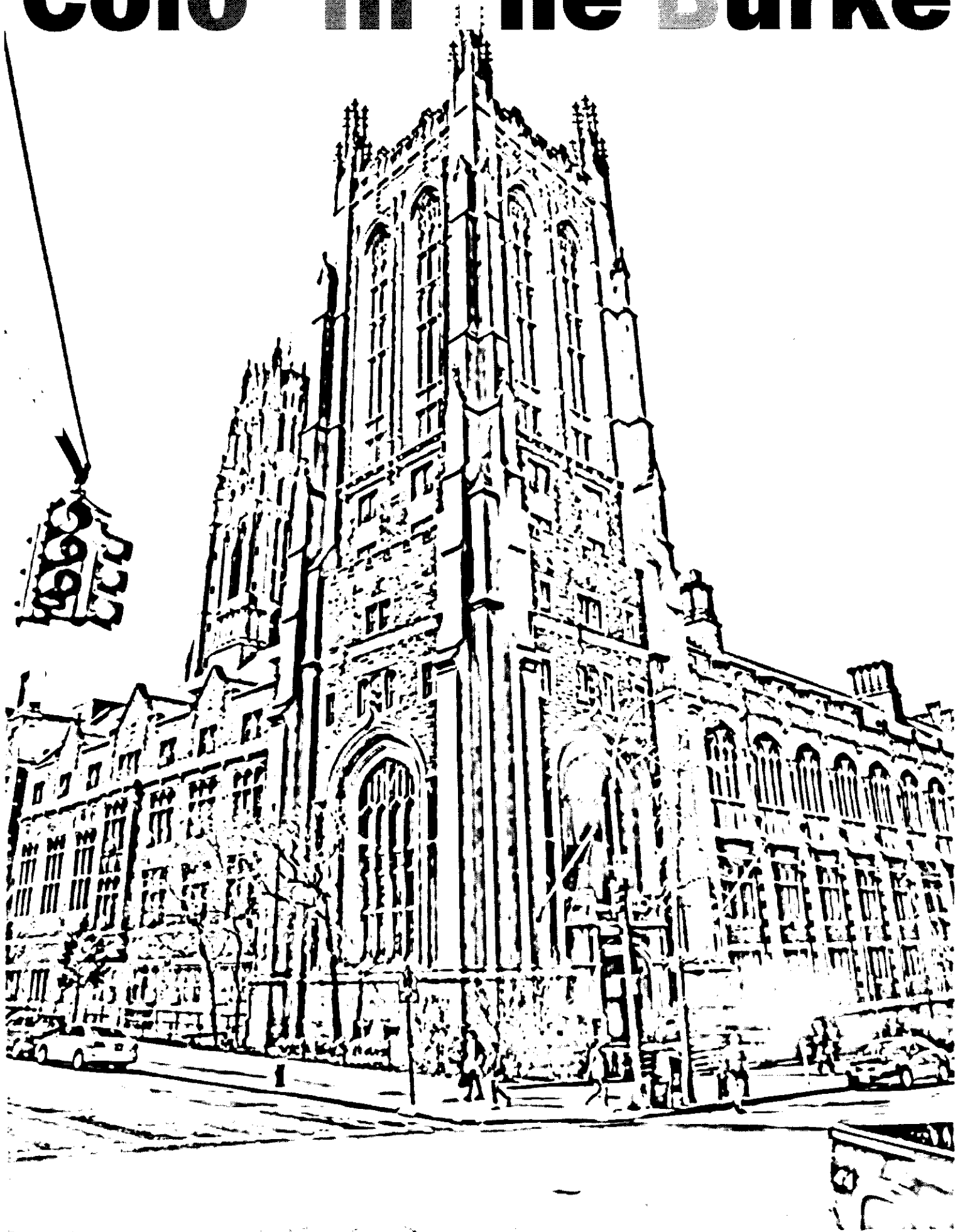
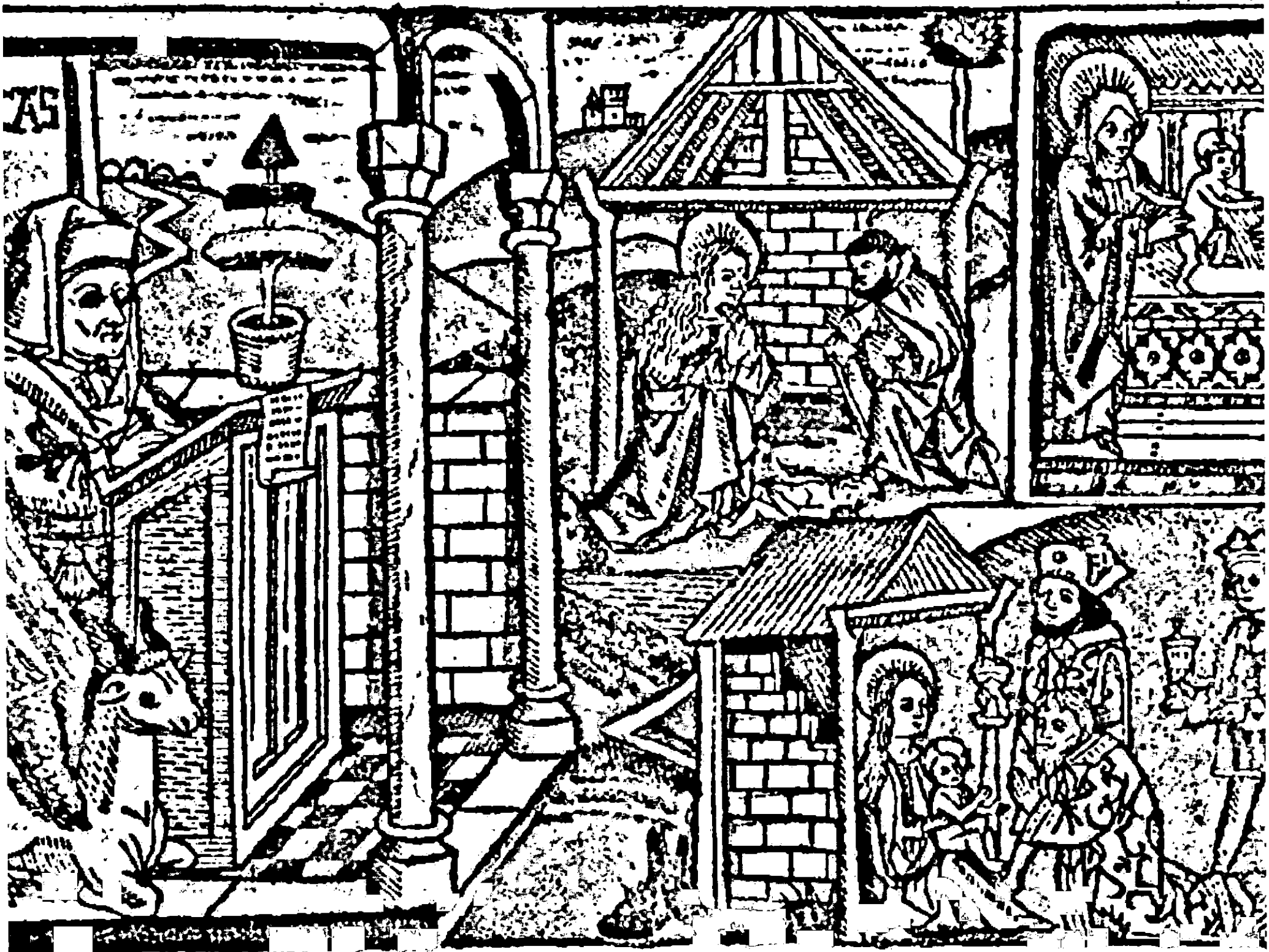

3. One Fig to the full proportion.

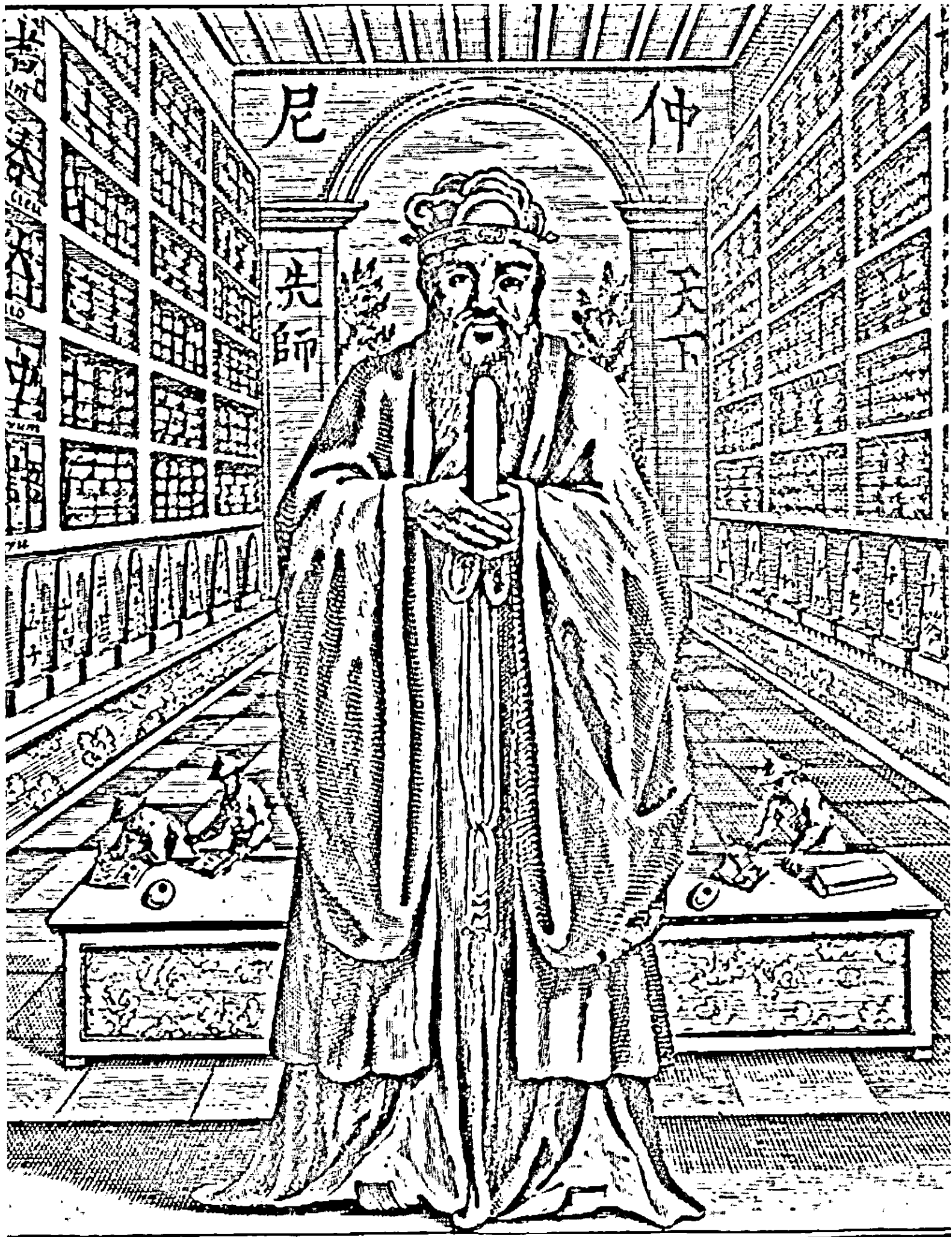
4. The young shoots that spring from the

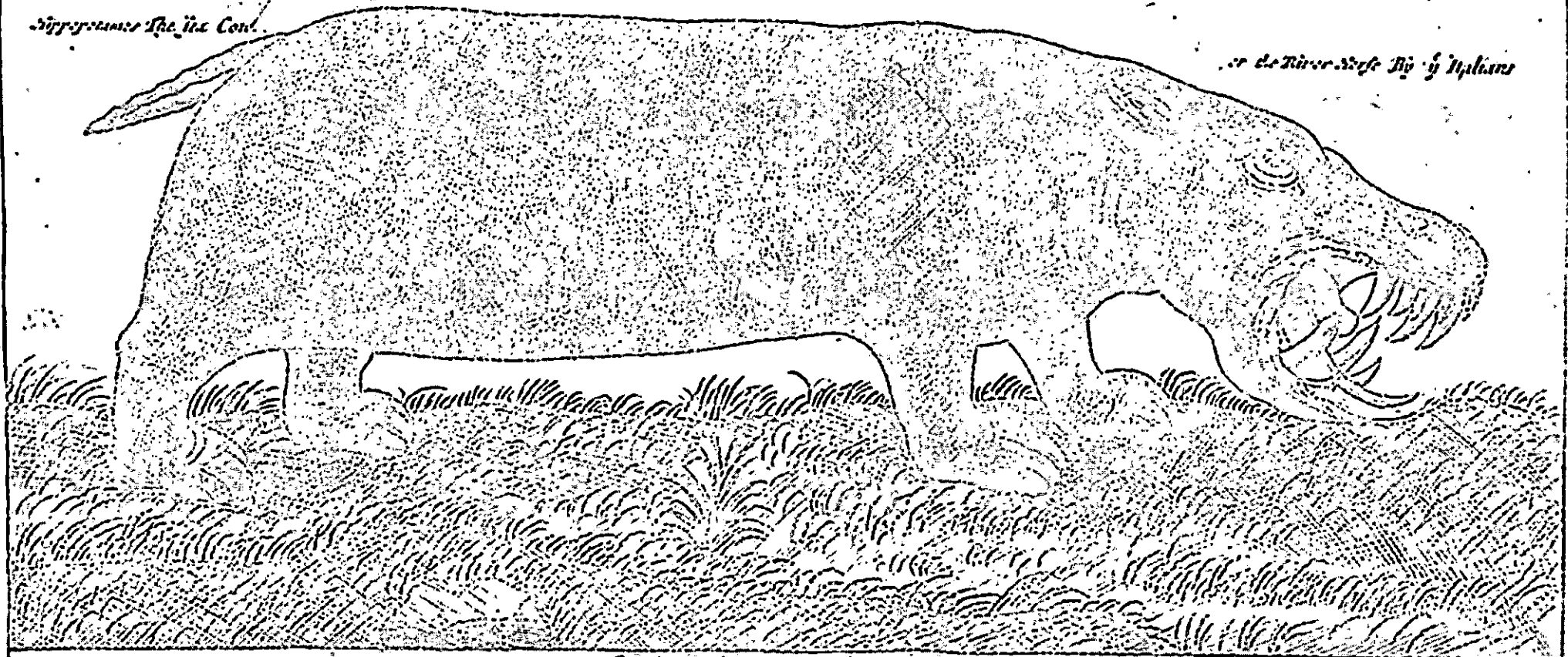
